49 to 52	9. What did the blind man do when Jesus called him and why did Jesus say he could heal him?	The blind man cast away his cloak and came to Jesus. Jesus healed him because he had faith.

Psalms 49 v 6 to 10	Riches can't buy life after this one ends.
Proverbs 22 v 1 to 4	There are more important things in life than trying to be rich.
Proverbs 28 v 11	Being rich encourages pride.
1 Timothy 6 v 9 and 10	The apostle Paul warns Timothy:  > those who want to be rich are on a road to ruin and destruction > the love of money results in all kinds of evil > loving money can lead us away from the faith
