1 and 2	What were they [the Pharisees] doing in the synagogue?	They wanted to accuse him. So they were watching to see if he would heal a man with a withered hand on the Sabbath day.
3 to 6	2. What was Jesus teaching the Pharisees about their ritual keeping of the Sabbath?	That it was within the law to do good on the Sabbath, and that their ritual keeping was misguided.
7 to 12	3. What attracted the people to come to Jesus?	Jesus' ability to heal people attracted large crowds.
13 to 21	4. For what purpose did Jesus select the twelve?	Jesus chose twelve disciples to help him with the work of preaching and healing.
22	5. What did the scribes say about Jesus' healings?	The scribes said Jesus healed by the prince of demons.
23 to 30	6. What warning did Jesus give them in reply?	Jesus warned them that by refusing to acknowledge the power of the Holy Spirit, and attributing it to the prince of demons, they were in grave danger of judgement.
31 to 35	7. Who did Jesus say were his family?	He said that those who did the will of God were part of his family.
