Genesis 15	
	We continue our journey through the book of Genesis from chapter 13. We left Abram just as he separated from his nephew Lot. Abram was counted righteous because he believed what God had said. God foretells that Abram's descendants would become slaves for a time. They did become slaves in Egypt.
1.	To what did God liken the large number of the offspring he promised Abram?
2.	What was the result of Abram believing God's promise that he would have a child?
3.	In verse 18 Abram's offspring are promised all the land from the Euphrates to the river of Egypt. Look at the map of Canaanite nations at the end, what countries occupy these lands now?

Day 2

Genesis 17	
	God's promises are renewed. Abram's name is changed to Abraham which means "father of many nations". The promise was to go through Isaac, not Ishmael.
1.	What does God ask Abram to do when he is 99 years old and what will be the result?
2.	What is to be the name of Sarah's son?
3.	What does God promise to do for Ishmael?

Day 3

Genesis 19	
	Sodom is destroyed because of its moral wickedness. Lot and his daughters are delivered from the destruction. Lot's daughters have illicit relations with their father.
1.	Lot sat in the gate of Sodom, meaning that he was in a position of influence. How do we know that he was never really accepted by the people of Sodom?
2.	Why did Lot's wife become a pillar of salt?
3.	What two nations come from Lot's daughters' illicit relations with their father?



Day 4

Genesis 22	
	Abraham's faith is severely tested.
1.	Where was Abraham told to go to sacrifice his son, Isaac?
2.	What does Abraham say that makes us think he believed God would raise Isaac if he sacrificed him?
3.	Why did God ask Abraham to sacrifice Isaac?

Day 5

Genesis 26	
	God's promises to Isaac
1.	What was Isaac told not to do despite the fact that there was a famine?
2.	What was the lie Isaac told about his wife?
3.	What had Abimelech and Ahuzzath noticed about Isaac?

Day 6

Genesis 27	
	Jacob deceives his father, Isaac
1.	What meat did Isaac ask Esau for and what meat did Rebekah use to deceive him?
2.	In verses 19 to 24, how many lies does Jacob tell?
3.	What does Isaac say before he blesses Jacob that indicates he was very suspicious?

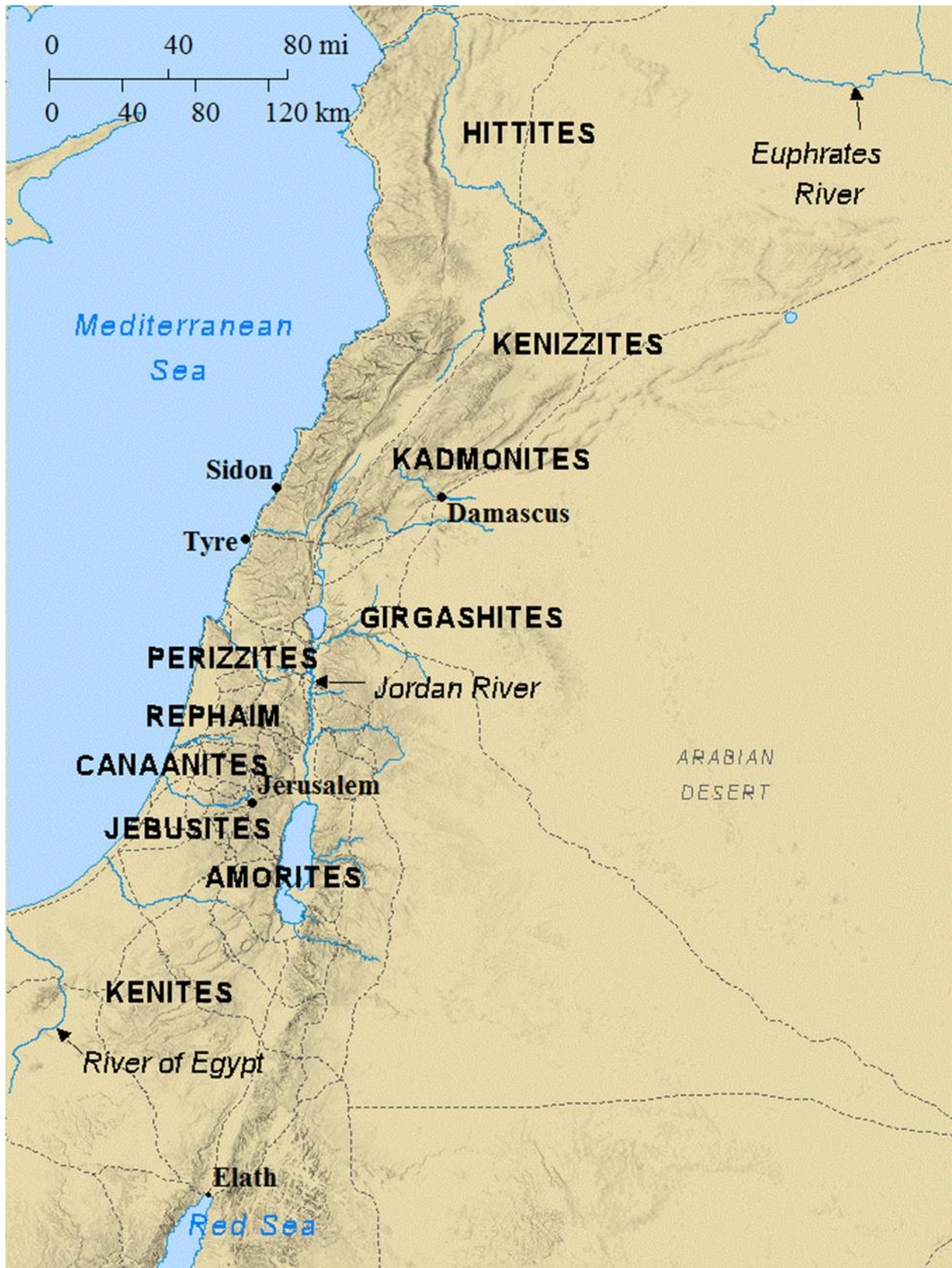
Day 7
