	Two sons of Aaron decide to worship God in their own way.				
1.	What did Nadab and Abihu do that was wrong?				
2.	What were the priests told not to do before entering the Tent of Meeting?				
3.	What two specific types of meat were the priests and their families given to eat in a holy place?

	Aaron is given instructions for the day of atonement when he 'makes atonement for' (cleanses) the whole nation.
