1.	How does God describe the land he is encouraging them to possess?
2.	What did the people want to do before taking possession of the land?
3.	What was the reaction of the people to the spies' report?

Day 2

Deuteronomy 2	
	Moses reminds the Israelites of events while they were in the wilderness.
1.	Why did the LORD stop the Israelites from contending with the inhabitants of Seir?
2.	What does the LORD tell Moses about contending with Moab?
3.	How many years did it take for all the men of war who had refused to go into the land, to die in the wilderness?

Day 3

Deuteronomy 3	
	Early conquests on the eastern side of Jordan.
1.	What did the LORD say to Moses when Og the king of Bashan came out against them?
2.	To which three tribes did Moses give the land of the two kings of the Amorites?
3.	From which mountain was Moses able to see all of the promised land?



Day 4

Deuteronomy 6	
	Moses reminds the Israelites of the importance of keeping God's commands and trusting in him
1.	What did God say would happen if they heard and observed his commandments?
2.	Why did Moses say the people shouldn't go after other gods?
3.	What were the Israelites to tell their sons when they asked what the LORD' commandments were all about?

Day 5

Deuteronomy 8	
	Moses encourages the Israelites as they are about to enter the promised land.
1.	Why did God take the Israelites through the wilderness on the way to the promised land?
2.	What was miraculous about their forty years in the wilderness?
3.	What problems did Moses say they faced in the wilderness?

Day 6

Deuteronomy 18	
	Moses reminds the Israelites of the duties and responsibilities of Levites, priests and prophets.
1.	The people gave parts of their sacrifices for the priests to eat. What other things were they instructed to supply for them?
2.	What warning were the Israelites to remember when they came into the land which God was giving them?
3.	What did Moses say would happen to a false prophet?



Day 7

Deuteronomy 28	
	Moses gives the blessings and curses which the Israelites would have depending whether they were obedient to God or not.
1.	What did the Israelites need to do to obtain blessings rather than curses?
2.	If the Israelites did not obey God, what would they get instead of rain?
3.	Which verse in the blessings, is the opposite to the curse in verse 44?
