	Mark 10					
	More guidance from Jesus on how we should live. He tells his disciples that he must die and rise again. He heals a blind man.					
1.	What does Jesus say about marriage?					
2.	What does Jesus say makes it difficult to enter God's Kingdom?					
3.	Following the ambitious request of James and John, what does Jesus say we should do if we want to be great?					

Day 3

	Mark 11					
	Jesus rides into Jerusalem on a donkey. He clears the traders from the temple and has his authority questioned.					
1.	What did Jesus say the Jews had made the temple into?					
2.	Under what circumstances will God not forgive us?					
3.	What would be the consequence for the Jewish leaders in saying that the baptism of John was from heaven?

	Mark 12
	Jesus continues teaching in the temple with increasingly hostile reactions from the religious leaders.
1.	Why couldn't Jesus' enemies seize him?
2.	Why were the Pharisees and Herodians sent to Jesus?
3.	What was the disciples' problem with the storm? What, did Jesus say, had caused them to feel that way?

Day 5

	Mark 13					
	The disciples point out the greatness of the temple. But Jesus predicts its destruction and goes on to talk about his return to the earth.					
1.	What was the first problem Jesus warned his followers about?					
2.	What family problems did Jesus warn about?					
3.	Who did Jesus say didn't know "the day or the hour"?					

Day 6

	Mark 14					
	Events which lead up to the arrest of Jesus in Gethsemane. Jesus is then given a mock trial by the religious authorities.					
1.	What did Jesus say about the person who would betray him?					
2.	What things does Jesus say come "from within, out of the hearts of men"?					
3.	When did Jesus say he would drink wine again?					

Day 7

	Mark 15				
	After a sham trial, Jesus is crucified, dies and is buried.				
1.	The crowd, that had a few days before shouted "Hosanna" now shouted "crucify him". Who had changed their minds?				
2.	How long was Jesus on the cross before he died?				
3.	What happened when Jesus took his last breath?
