1.	How does the LORD describe the children of Israel and their fathers?
2.	What will the children of Israel know, whether or not they listen to Ezekiel?
3.	What was in the scroll of a book that Ezekiel was given?

Day 2

Ezekiel 3	
	Ezekiel is made responsible for giving the LORD's message to the people of Israel.
1.	Why does the LORD say the house of Israel will not listen to Ezekiel?
2.	What does the LORD say to Ezekiel about his responsibilities as a watchman to the wicked men?
3.	What does the Lord GOD tell Ezekiel about his ability to talk?

Day 3

Ezekiel 18	
	Ezekiel tells the Israelites that they will be individually responsible for what they do.
1.	What does the Lord GOD say about someone who has walked in His statutes and kept His ordinances?
2.	What does the Lord GOD say about someone who has wronged the poor and needy and has taken by robbery?
3.	How does the Lord GOD say He will judge the house of Israel?

Day 4

Ezekiel 36 3	
	God promises that Israel will return to their own land.
1.	What does the Lord God say He will do because Israel has borne the shame of the nations?
2.	What did the Lord GOD do when He judged Israel according to their deeds?
3.	How will the Lord GOD sanctify His great name which has been profaned among the nations



Day 5

Ezekiel 37	
	A vision of the revival of the nation of Israel.
1.	Who do the bones represent? What should Ezekiel prophesy because the bones are dried up and their hope is lost?
2.	What will the LORD's people know when He has caused them to come up out of their graves?
3.	What does the LORD say will happen when His servant David is king over them?

Day 6

Ezekiel 38	
	A prophecy of the final attack by the enemies of Israel.
1.	What is the land like, in the latter years, before the army invades?
2.	What is the motivation for the army to attack?
3.	How will God enter into judgement with the army for attacking Israel and what will be the purpose of the judgement?

Day 7

Ezekiel 39	
	Ezekiel prophesies the destruction of the enemies of Israel.
1.	What will happen to this invading army on the mountains of Israel?
2.	How long will it take to cleanse the land?
3.	What will the house of Israel and the nations know as a result of the LORD's judgements?
