Questions

- 1.What meat did Isaac ask Esau for and what meat did Rebekah use to deceive him?
- 2.In verses 19 to 24, how many lies does Jacob tell?
- 3. What does Isaac say before he blesses Jacob that indicates he is very suspicious?

Summary Points

- v1 to 4 Isaac asks Esau to hunt and get some venison so that he can bless him
- **v 5 to 17** Isaac's wife Rebekah hears what Isaac has said to Esau and tells Jacob to co-operate in her plan to get Isaac to bless Jacob instead of Esau. Rebekah dismisses Jacob's comments about being deceitful
- v 18 to 29 After telling several lies, Jacob is blessed by Isaac
- **v 30 to 40** Esau returns from hunting and discovers that Jacob has been blessed instead of him. Isaac upholds the blessing to Jacob and gives Esau a lesser blessing (see theme)
- **v 41 to 46** Esau's plan to kill Jacob is known to Rebekah who tells Jacob to go to her brother Laban in Haran to escape Esau's planned revenge

God's promises to Esau

A selection of verses relating to the promises given to Esau. Esau's father Isaac promises him a fertile land:

Genesis 27 verse 39

The promise is fulfilled. Esau becomes the father of the Edomites:

Genesis 36 verses 6 to 9

God tells Moses that he has given Esau Mount Seir (now south west Jordan) as hispossession:

Deuteronomy 2 verse 5

God tells the people in Joshua's time that he's given Mount Seir to Esau:

Joshua 24 verse 4
