Summary Points

- **v 1 to 7** We should respect the God-ordained authorities, obeying the laws and requirements of our country
- **v 8 to 10** We should love our neighbours as ourselves, not causing them any harm
- **v 11 to 14** Our salvation (at the return of Jesus) gets nearer each day. So we should live with Jesus as our example (see theme), not getting involved in activities that satisfy our lusts

A selection of verses showing that Christ should be our example in life.

Jesus encourages his disciples to follow his example:

Luke 9 verse 23

The apostle Paul gives similar encouragement:

Ephesians 5 verse 2

Philippians 2 verses 4 and 5

The apostle Peter adds to Paul's encouragement:

Peter 2 verse 21

Paul encourages his readers to follow his example in following Christ's example:

1 Corinthians 11 verse 1
