# **Summary Points**

- v 1 to 6 God's plan through Jesus Christ is lost on those who look only at what this world offers
- v 7 to 12 Paul's body is frail, and he has many enemies, but despite this he can show forth the message of life in the Lord Jesus
- v 13 to 15 Paul's faith in the resurrection (see theme) makes him preach this hope to others
- v 16 to 18 Paul views his mortal frailty and hardships as temporary and insignificant compared with the eternal glory to come

#### Resurrection at the return of Jesus Christ

A selection of verses showing that the resurrection will be at the return of Jesus Christ.

Jesus confirms the confidence that his friend Martha expresses in the resurrection:

John 11 verses 23 and 24

The apostle Paul tells the Corinthians that people will be raised at the return of Jesus:

1 Corinthians 15 verses 22 and 23

He gives a similar message to the Thessalonians:

1 Thessalonians 4 verse 16
