Summary Points

- **v 1 to 11** Jesus is led by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil (see theme). He resists by remembering Old Testament Scriptures and chooses to obey them despite attractive alternatives
- **v 12 to 17** Jesus moves to Galilee and starts teaching as predicted by Isaiah (Isaiah 9 v 1 and 2). He teaches repentance because the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand
- **v 18 to 22** Jesus calls James and John to be his disciples.
- **v 23 to 25** Jesus preaches and heals. Many people from Galilee, Decapolis, Jerusalem, Judea and beyond the Jordan (see map) follow him
