Summary Points

- **v 1 to 14** Jesus gives more advice on how we should live:
 - We will be judged in the same way that we judge others (v 1 and 2)
 - Don't judge others harshly because we are probably as bad as them (v 3 to 5)
 - Don't try to give God's message to those who obviously don't want it (v 6)
 - Like ordinary fathers, God will give us things that will be good for us if we ask him (v 7 to 12)
 - Not many will find the restricted way to life (v 13 and 14)
 - Jesus warns us to beware of those who would lead us astray (see theme)
 - We can recognise such people by the results of what they do. They will eventually be rejected by Jesus (v 15 to 23)
- **v 24 to 29** Jesus likens those who listen to him to a wise man who builds a house that resists all the storms that come against it

The apostle Paul tells the believers at Ephesus and Colossae to resist deceptive ideas:

Ephesians 5 verse 6

Colossians 2 verses 4 and 8

The apostle Paul gives several warnings that believers will encounter wrong ideas:

1 Timothy 4 verses 1 and 2

2 Timothy 4 verses 3 and 4

The apostle John tells the believers to test the spirits (ideas) they come across:

1 John 4 verse 1
