



Introduction

At the end of chapter 46 Jacob's family had just moved into Egypt because of a famine. Jacob's now settle in Egypt and the family famine continues.



Questions

1. What are the two different names in this chapter of the land that the children of Israel occupied?
2. Why did Pharaoh end up owning all the livestock and most of the land in Egypt?
3. What instructions did Jacob give to Joseph about his burial?



Summary Points

- **v 1 to 12** Joseph introduces his family to Pharaoh who allows them to in the land of Rameses, in Goshen (see map, point 4) - one of the best parts of Egypt settle
- **v 13 to 26** The famine continues and the people of Egypt and Canaan sell everything to Pharaoh for food. They are then provided with seed on condition that they give one fifth of future harvests to Pharaoh
- **v 27 to 31** Jacob lives for 17 years in Goshen, but he makes Joseph promise that when he dies, Joseph will bury him with his fathers in Canaan

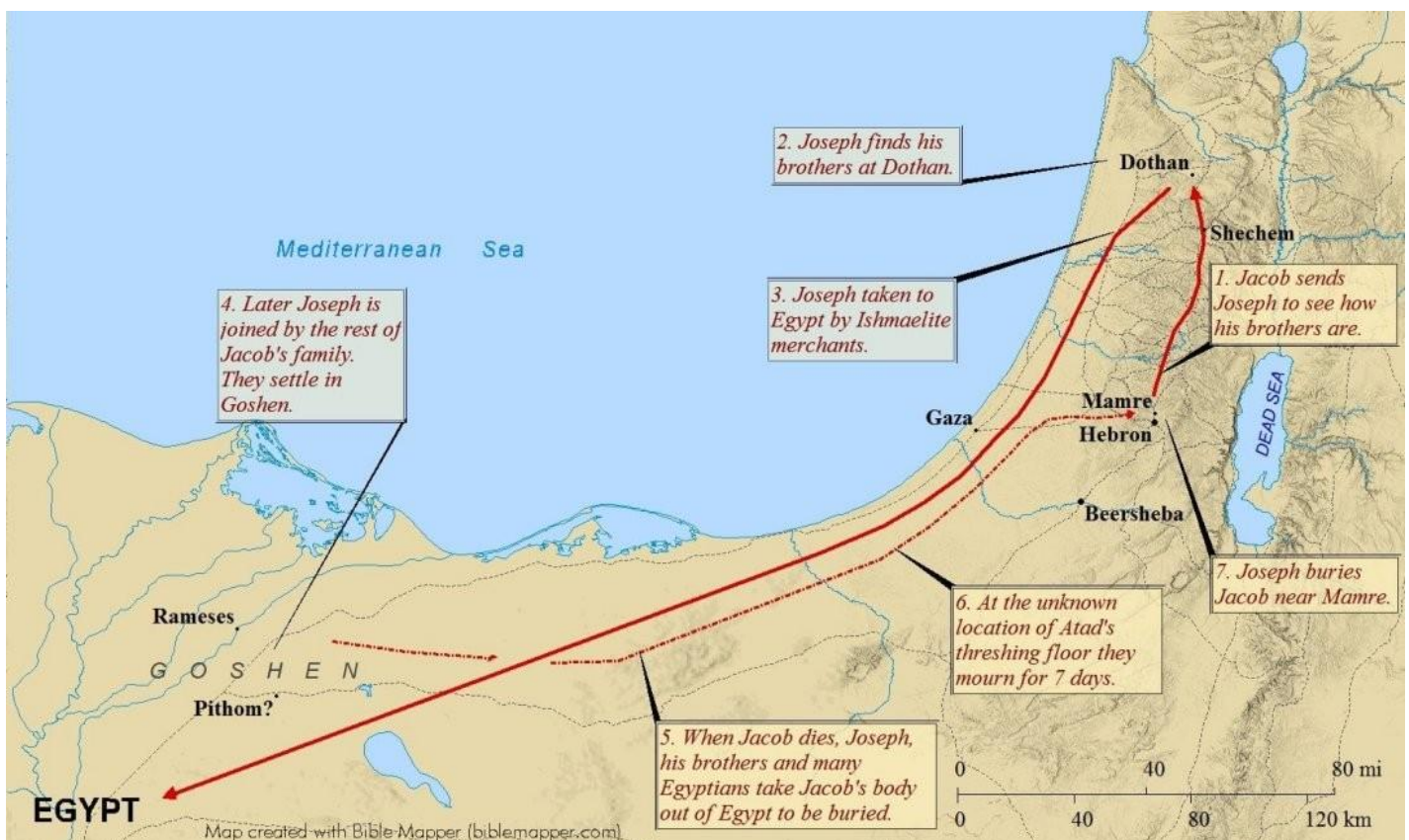
Timeline to 2000 BC (see below)
