Questions

- 1. What two signs did God give Moses to prove that he sent him?
- 2. What did God say he would do to Pharaoh to stop him letting the people go?
- 3. Who were the first people Aaron and Moses showed the two signs to?



Summary Points

- v 1 to 9 Moses tells the LORD that the people won't believe that he has appeared • to him. So Moses is given signs (see theme) to show he has been sent by the LORD
- v 10 to 17 Moses is reluctant to take on the job the LORD is asking of him and wants somebody else to do it. The support of his brother Aaron is promised and the LORD says he will be with Moses' mouth
- v 18 to 26 Moses asks to leave Jethro. The LORD assures him his life will no longer be in danger in Egypt. Moses collects his wife and sons to go to Egypt. The LORD tells him to perform the signs to Pharaoh who will take no notice of them. On the way to Egypt Zipporah circumcises her son
- v 27 to 31 God tells Aaron to meet Moses and they go back to Egypt (see map). They gather the elders of the children of Israel together and perform the signs. The people then believe what Moses and Aaron are telling them
