Introduction

Christ tells parables about the Kingdom of Heaven.

Questions

- 1. In the parable of the farmer, what type of person does the seed sown on good ground represent?
- 2. In these parables, who does Jesus say will separate the wicked from the righteous?
- 3. What two things does Jesus say the Kingdom of Heaven is as precious as?

Summary Points

- v 1 to 9 Jesus gives a parable about a farmer whose seed lands on different types of ground
- v 10 to 15 Parables hide the message of the Kingdom of Heaven (See theme) from those who don't really want to hear it, fulfilling a prophecy in Isaiah
- v 16 and 17 The disciples are blessed because they do see
- v 18 to 23 The parable of the farmer illustrates different reactions from people who hear the word of the Kingdom
- v 24 to 30 In this parable weeds and good seed develop together until harvest time
- v 31 to 33 The Kingdom of Heaven is like:
 - o a small seed that becomes a big tree
 - o yeast which spreads through all the quantity of meal
- v 34 and 35 Jesus speaking in parables was predicted by the prophets
- v 36 to 43 The parable of the weeds shows that the children of the Kingdom grow alongside the children of the evil one. At the end of the age, they are separated
- v 44 to 50 More illustrations of what the Kingdom of Heaven is like:
 - o treasure, which a man sells all he has to buy
 - o an expensive pearl, which a merchant sells all he has to buy
 - o a dragnet which gathers all kinds of fish. The angels separate these into good and bad and the bad are destroyed
- v 51 and 52 Disciples understanding these things will be able to pass them on
- v 53 to 58 Jesus' teaching is not believed by those in his home area who have seen him grow up
