## Questions

## Summary Points

- **v 1 to 12** When questioned about divorce, Jesus explains that marriage ought to be for life (see theme). Jesus then says that some will not be able to accept this
- **v 13 to 15** Children are brought to Jesus and he says that the Kingdom of Heaven belongs to people like these little children
- **v 16 to 22** A young man says he has kept all the commandments that Jesus mentions. Jesus tells him he needs to give all he has to the poor if he wants to be perfect. The young man goes away sad
- **v 23 to 26** Jesus says that riches will make entering God's kingdom difficult. It can only be done with God's help
- **v 27 to 30** Jesus tells the disciples that they will be judges over the tribes of Israel when he sits on his throne (see theme)

## Themes

### God's view of marriage

*A selection of verses showing how a consistent view of marriage runs through the Bible.*

God lays out the principles of marriage very early in the Bible:

*Genesis 2 verses 23 and 24*

One of Abraham's great grandsons, Joseph, shows that he respects God's view of marriage:

*Genesis 39 verses 7 to 9*

King David is reprimanded for taking another man's wife:

*2 Samuel 12 verses 9 and 10*

The book of Proverbs warns against taking another man's wife:

*Proverbs 6 verses 28 and 29*

Jesus Christ also gives us the principles of marriage:

*Matthew 19 verses 3 to 9*

The apostle Paul gives more advice:

*Ephesians 5 verses 28 to 31*



### **Jesus Christ will rule over all nations**

*A selection of verses showing that Christ will rule over all nations.*

The Psalms talk about a king ruling over all nations from Zion which is part of Jerusalem:

*Psalms 2 verses 6 to 9*

The prophet Isaiah predicts a special son to be born who will lead a powerful, worldwide, endless kingdom:

*Isaiah 9 verses 6 and 7*

The prophet Daniel foretells that God will set up a worldwide kingdom replacing all existing nations:

*Daniel 2 verse 44*

The prophet Daniel sees a vision indicating that God (the ancient of days) will give a son rulership over a worldwide permanent kingdom:

*Daniel 7 verses 13 and 14*

The apostle Paul talks about Jesus Christ becoming a ruler over all the world:

*1 Corinthians 15 verses 24 and 25*

The book of Revelation is clear:

*Revelation 11 verse 15*
