Introduction

Problems over lack of water.

Questions

- 1. What did Moses say that the people were doing by guarrelling with him?
- 2. What did Moses say to the LORD that indicated the anger of the people?
- 3. What did Moses have to do to enable the Israelites to defeat Amalek?



Summary Points

- v 1 to 4 The Israelites complain (see theme) angrily to Moses when they find there is no water to drink after they move to Rephidim (see map)
- v 5 to 7 The LORD tells Moses to strike a rock which then provides water for the people
- v 8 to 16 The people of Amalek come and fight Israel. Moses sends Joshua to fight Amalek. Moses, Aaron and Hur go up a hill. Moses holds God's rod high in the air and Joshua defeats the Amalekites

We should trust God rather than complain

On two occasions, Moses asks God to help when the children of Israel complain about lackof water:

Exodus 15 verses 24 and 25, 17 verses 2 to 4

In the Psalms God tells us to ask him if we have problems:

Psalm 50 verse 15

The psalmist tells us to ask God if we have problems:

Psalm 55 verse 22

The Lord Jesus tells us that God is aware of our needs and that God will provide if we seekhis Kingdom:


