Summary Points

- **v 1 and 2** Follow Christ's example (see theme) of showing love
- **v 3 to 5** Paul lists the people who won't be in God's Kingdom
- **v 6 to 14** We should keep away from those who would lead us in ungodly ways. Walking in light pleases the Lord
- **v 15 to 21** We are to use our time in spiritual ways, thanking God in the name of Jesus Christ
- **v 22 to 24** Wives are to be subject to their husbands in the same way that the assembly of believers is subject to Christ
- **v 25 to 30** Husbands are to love their wives in the same way that Christ loved the assembly of believers. He gave himself up for it so that it could be without defect
- **v 31 to 33** Husband and wife become one flesh reflecting the relationship between Christ and the assembly of believers

1 Peter 2 verse 21

Paul encourages his readers to follow his example in following Christ's example:

1 Corinthians 11 verse 1
