Summary Points

- **v 1 to 8** The Jews are a privileged people because God gave them his revelations. The fact that they don't have faith in God doesn't make God less true or just. We can't deliberately do evil so that God can show his goodness to us
- **v 9 to 20** Because we are all sinners (see theme), we can't be justified (made right) by what we do
- **v 21 to 26** Now, by God's grace, anyone can be counted righteous (right with God) through faith in the sacrifice of Jesus Christ
- **v 27 to 31** We should not boast, as we are saved by what we believe, not by keeping laws
