### **Summary Points**

- v 1 to 3 We must show love, otherwise all that we do is of no value
- **v 4 to 7** We are shown that love:
  - o is selfless and not proud
  - $\circ~$  is not easily provoked and doesn't bear grudges
  - o holds to what is true and dislikes what is wrong
  - o endures all problems
- **v 8 to 13** Love is the attribute that will continue past our present partial knowledge and experience
