Introduction

Paul is pleased by Timothy's encouraging report of the Thessalonians.

Questions

Summary Points

- v 1 to 5 Paul had sent Timothy from Athens to ensure their faith was not discouraged by their problems
- v 6 and 7 Timothy returned with good news about how faithfully the believers were coping
- v 8 to 10 Paul thanks God for their standing fast in the Lord and wants to see them again to help them further in their faith
- v 11 to 13 Paul prays to God for three things:
 - o that he be allowed to visit the Thessalonians again
 - o that their love for one another (see theme) will increase
 - o that they may be found blameless at the coming of the Lord Jesus
