## **Summary Points**

- v 1 to 8 The Thessalonian believers are encouraged to try more and more to please God in their lives by avoiding sexual immorality
- v 9 to 12 They are to increase their kindness towards one another and work to support themselves
- v 13 to 15 They are concerned about their members who have died. Paul reassures them they will be raised from the dead at the return of Jesus (see theme).
- v 16 to 18 Paul says that at the coming of Christ the dead in Christ will rise first. They will then be joined by believers who are still alive to meet Jesus Christ

### Resurrection at the return of Jesus Christ

A selection of verses showing that the resurrection will be at the return of Jesus Christ.

Jesus confirms the confidence that his friend Martha expresses in the resurrection:

John 11 verses 23 and 24

The apostle Paul tells the Corinthians that people will be raised at the return of Jesus:

1 Corinthians 15 verses 22 and 23

He gives a similar message to the Thessalonians:

1 Thessalonians 4 verse 16


