



## Introduction

*Moses reminds the Israelites of events while they were in the wilderness.*



## Questions

1. Why did the LORD stop the Israelites from contending with the inhabitants of Seir?
2. What does the LORD tell Moses about contending with Moab?
3. How many years did it take for all the men of war who had refused to go into the land, to die in the wilderness?



## Summary Points

- **v 1 to 8** After spending time going round Mount Seir (see map), the people went north and passed by the Edomites, because they were relatives. Moses reminds them that God has provided for them through all their problems
- **v 9 to 23** They were also to respect the lands of the Moabites and Ammonites as they had been given to them by God
- **v 24 to 37** Moses reminds them of their defeat of Sihon king of the Amorites. Moses sent messengers from the wilderness of Kedemoth (see map) to Sihon. He offered to stay on the highway and buy food and water from him. But Sihon came out prepared for battle and was defeated at Jahaz (see map)

### God is with his people

*A selection of verses showing that God promises always to be with his people.*

God promises to be with Abraham's son [Isaac] and his grandson [Jacob]:

*Genesis 26 verse 3, 28 verse 15*

God says he will be with Joshua as he was with Moses :

*Joshua 1 verse 5*

God says he was with David wherever he went. He has destroyed his enemies and made him great:

*2 Samuel 7 verses 8 and 9*

David asks that God will be with his son Solomon in building the temple:

*1 Chronicles 22 verse 11*

Jesus Christ promises that he and God will be with those who love him:

*John 14 verse 23*

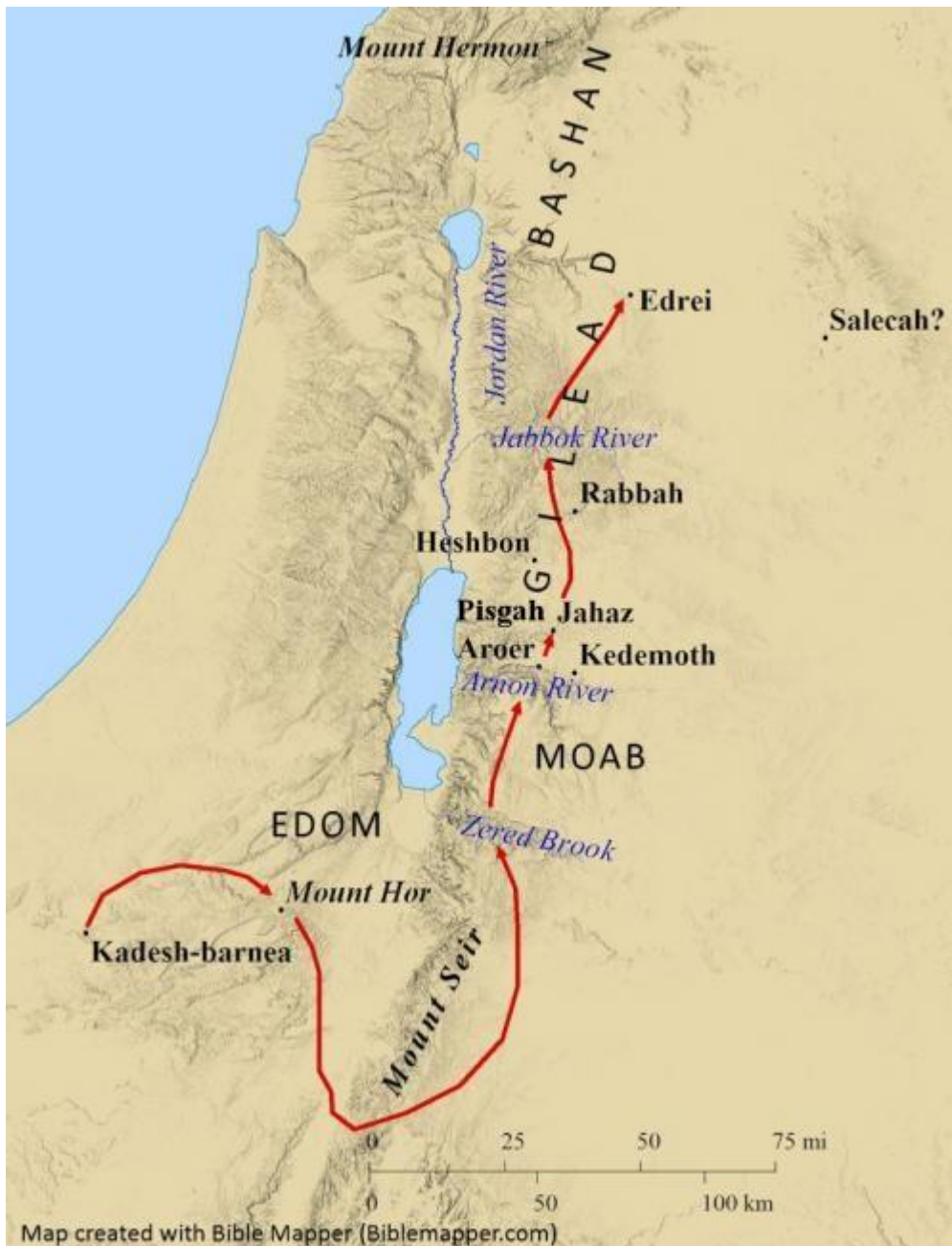
Paul ends his letter to the Romans by asking that God may be with the early believers:

*Romans 15 verse 33*
