## Questions

1. What did the LORD say to Moses when Og the king of Bashan came out against them?
2. To which three tribes did Moses give the land of the two kings of the Amorites?
3. From which mountain was Moses able to see all of the promised land?



## Summary Points

- **v 1 to 11** Moses reminds the people that Og king of Bashan came out to battle against the Israelites at Edrei (see map) and was defeated. They took 60 of his cities in addition to the land they had already taken from Sihon (chapter 2)
- **v 12 to 17** The land they had taken was shared out among three tribes
- **v 18 to 22** The three tribes were to help the other tribes to conquer the land beyond Jordan. Joshua was encouraged by knowing that God would go with him
- **v 23 to 29** Moses was disappointed not to be going into the promised land but God allowed him to see it from the top of Pisgah (see map). God then told him to commission Joshua (see theme) as his successor to lead the people into the land he could see

## Theme / Information

### Joshua

*A selection of verses showing some significant events in the life of Joshua.*

Joshua was the leader of Israel under God, after the death of Moses. This was just before his people entered the land of promise to be later known as Israel.

Joshua was first mentioned when he was leading the Israelites in battle:

*Exodus 17 verses 9 and 10*

He worked closely with Moses; he accompanied Moses in his dealings with God:

*Exodus 24 verse 13*

When it was time for him to lead Israel he was told to have no fear as God would be with him:

*Deuteronomy 3 verses 21 and 22*

He was encouraged to be courageous but also to study God's law constantly:

*Joshua 1 verses 8 and 9*

Joshua is perhaps best remembered for his conquest of the mighty walled city of Jericho:

*Joshua 6 verse 2*

Joshua encouraged the people to serve God:

*Joshua 24 verse 14*

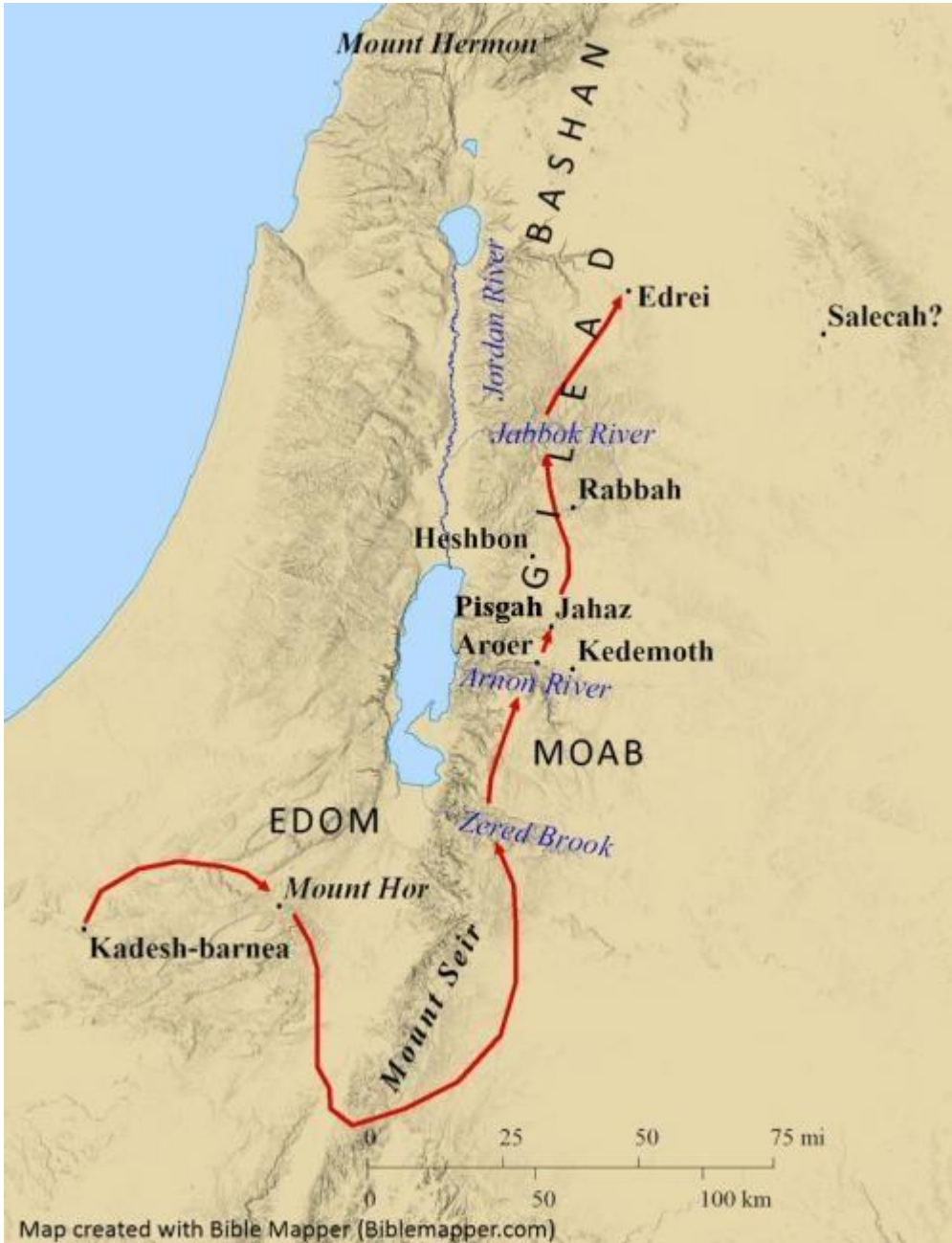
Joshua died after a long life of service to the LORD:

*Joshua 24 verse 29*
