Introduction

Moses encourages the Israelites as they are about to enter the promised land.

Questions

- 1. Why did God take the Israelites through the wilderness on the way to the promised land?
- 2. What was miraculous about their forty years in the wilderness?
- 3. What problems did Moses say they faced in the wilderness?



Summary Points

- v 1 to v 6 Moses encourages their obedience to God (see theme) and reviews their experiences during the wilderness journey emphasizing how God has looked after them on a day to day basis
- v 7 to 10 Moses emphasizes the wonder of the land they are about to enter
- v 11 to 18 Don't forget God, who led you through the wilderness and provided for you, when you become prosperous in the land
- v 19 and 20 They will perish like the nations round them if they turn from the LORD their God to worship other gods

Obedience

A selection of verses showing that God asks us to be obedient to him.

The Israelites are promised that they will be precious to God if they obey him:

Exodus 19 verses 3 to 6

God spells out to the Israelites the consequences of obeying or disobeying:

Deuteronomy 11 verses 26 to 28

The prophet Isaiah tells us that God takes notice of those who obey him:

Isaiah 66 verse 2

The apostle Peter on two occasions is clear whom to obey when there is a conflict between obeying God or men:

Acts 4 verse 19, 5 verse 29
