Questions

- 1. How did the Jews know that the Roman centurion loved their nation?
- 2. How was John more than just a prophet?
- 3. What does Jesus say about how much we will love after being forgiven?

Summary Points

- v 1 to 10 At Capernaum (see map), Jesus heals a centurion's dying servant
- v 11 to 17 At Nain (see map), Jesus raises a widow woman's son (see theme), as the coffin bearers are taking him to be buried
- v 18 to 23 John the Baptiser sends a message to Jesus. Jesus replies that they should tell John about all the miracles and preaching they had seen and heard
- v 24 to 35 He then goes on to talk about John and compares himself with him
- v 36 to 50 At the house where Jesus is being entertained, a weeping woman has her sins forgiven after Jesus tells his Pharisee host a parable about forgiveness

Jesus' miracles show he is God's Son

A selection of verses showing that Jesus' miracles were evidence that he was God's Son.

Jesus' twelve disciples believed that Jesus was the Son of God because he stilled the distressing contrary wind on the sea of Galilee:

Matthew 14 verse 33

Jesus himself said that his miracles were testimony that he was Son of God:

John 15 verses 22 to 24

John says he wrote his gospel to show that Jesus was the Christ and also Son of God:

John 20 verses 30 and 31
