Jesus sends out 70 to heal and preach the Kingdom of God. He continues his teaching.



Questions

1. What did Jesus tell the seventy to do for those they met?
2. What did Jesus tell the seventy disciples would give them more joy than being able to heal people?
3. In Jesus' parable, which two Israelites disobeyed God's commandments, by not being neighbourly to the man?



Summary Points

- **v 1 to 24** Jesus sends out 70 to help with the work of preaching and healing. He condemns those cities which ignore the mighty works done in them. He rejoices with those who understand God's purpose
- **v 25 to 37** Jesus stresses the importance of love (see theme) and then tells the parable about the good Samaritan
- **v 38 to 42** Jesus is invited to the home of his good friends Martha and Mary

Love should be central in our lives

A selection of verses showing how this theme runs consistently through the Bible. God tells the Israelites that they should show love to all including those from other nations:

Leviticus 19 verse 18 and 34

God tells the Israelites to love him:

Deuteronomy 6 verse 5

The book of Proverbs gives a practical reason for showing love:

Proverbs 10 verse 12

Several New Testament letters encourage us to show love in our lives:

1 Thessalonians 3 verse 12

1 Timothy 1 verse 5

1 Peter 4 verse 8

The apostle John tells us the importance of showing love in our lives:

1 John 4 verse 7 and 11
