

### Introduction

# Questions

- 1. What did Jesus say the Jews had made the temple into?
- 2. Under what circumstances will God not forgive us?
- 3. What would be the consequence for the Jewish leaders in saying that the baptism of John was from heaven?

## **Summary Points**

- **v 1 to 11** People enthusiastically welcome Jesus as he enters Jerusalem. They link Jesus to the promises made to David (see theme)
- **12 to 19** Jesus curses a fig tree. Jesus throws the traders out of the temple because it should have been a house of prayer and quotes Isaiah 56 v 7. He says they have made it a den of robbers and quotes Jeremiah 7 v 11
- **v 20 to 26** The disciples notice the fig tree has withered. Jesus then teaches the importance of faith and forgiveness (see theme)
- **v 27 to 33** Jesus' authority is challenged by the Jewish leaders. He, in turn, challenges them with a question about the baptism of John

### **Themes / Information**

#### God's promises to David

God promises king David that he will have a special descendant whose reign will not end:

2 Samuel 7 verses 12 and 13

The same promise is also recorded in the Chronicles record:

1 Chronicles 17 verses 11 to 14

The Psalms say that God has promised to give David a descendant who will be king:

Psalm 89 verses 3 and 4, 132 verse 11

In their preaching, the apostles Peter and Paul say that Jesus is the special descendant promised to David:

Acts 2 verses 29 and 30, 13 verses 22 and 23



#### God's forgiveness depends on our forgiveness

A selection of verses showing that God and Christ will forgive us if we forgive others. Jesus Christ says:

Matthew 6 verses 14 and 15, 7 verse 2

The apostles Paul and James echo the same sentiment:

Ephesians 4 verse 32 Colossians 3 verse 13 James 2 verse 13
