Questions

- 1. What does Ruth suggest to Naomi that she should do and what happens?
- 2. What has Boaz been hearing about Ruth before he meets her?
- 3. What does Ruth end up doing for the rest of harvest time?

Summary Points

- v 1 to 7 To find food, Ruth goes out gleaning and happens to come to the field of Boaz
- v 8 to 16 Boaz shows kindness (see theme) to Ruth and tells her to continue gleaning in his field as he knows that she has put her trust in the God of Israel
- v 17 to 23 When Ruth tells Naomi what has happened Naomi tells her that Boaz is a close relative of theirs

Theme

Showing kindness

A selection of verses showing what the Bible tells us about showing kindness.

Kindness is one of God's characteristics:

Psalm 117 verses 1 and 2

God tells the prophet Isaiah that even if the physical world comes to an end, his kindness towards his people will still be there:

Isaiah 54 verse 10

The apostle Paul reminds the Ephesian believers that we can be saved because of God's kindness:

Ephesians 2 verse 7

He encourages the Colossian believers to respond to God's kindness by showing it themselves:

Colossians 3 verses 12 and 13
