- 1. What did Boaz say to the near kinsman and how did he respond?
- 2. The near kinsman was willing to buy the land, but what extra condition did Boaz say he had to fulfil, that put him off doing it?
- 3. Who was born as a result of Boaz marrying Ruth and who was born in subsequent generations?



Summary Points

- v 1 to 6 Boaz explains the situation to Naomi's closer relative but the relative declines to respond to Ruth's request
- v 7 to 12 Boaz calls the city elders to witness that he will buy Naomi's land and marry Ruth so that she can have children
- v 13 to 22 Boaz and Ruth have a son, Obed, who will be the grandfather of King David, an ancestor of Jesus (see theme)
