# Summary Points

- **v 1 to 8** Prayer should be a continuing part of our lives. We should not expect God to instantly solve our problems
- **v 9 to 14** When we pray we should not tell God what we are proud of, but recognise that we are sinful (see theme). However, we humbly believe that God will forgive us
- v 15 to 30 We need the right attitude to following Jesus so that we may enter God's Kingdom
- v 31 to 34 Jesus again says he is going to Jerusalem where he will suffer and die, then rise again the third day. But the disciples don't understand
- v 35 to 43 Jesus heals a blind man who recognises him as son of David
