# Questions

- 1. What do the men in dazzling clothes say to the women who look in Jesus' tomb?
- 2. What is the disciples' reaction when the women tell them what they have been told? What does Peter then do?
- 3. What does Jesus explain to the disciples on the road to Emmaus?

### **Summary Points**

- v 1 to 12 On the first day of the week the women visit the tomb and are told that Jesus has risen. They tell this to the disciples who don't believe them
- v 13 to 35 Jesus joins two disciples and explains that the prophets have said that the Christ must suffer before being glorified
- v 36 to 49 The resurrected and immortal Jesus spends time with his disciples explaining to them that the Old Testament Scriptures foretold his death and resurrection (see theme). They are to preach in his name repentance and remission of sins to all nations
- v 50 to 53 Jesus ascends to heaven watched by his disciples. They then return to Jerusalem and praise God in the temple

#### The work of Jesus was foretold in the Old Testament

A selection from the many verses showing that the work of Jesus was foretold in the Old Testament.

After his resurrection, on two occasions Jesus tells his disciples that his suffering and resurrection have been predicted in the Old Testament:

Luke 24 verses 25 to 27, 24 verses 44 to 47

Peter tells his hearers that several other prophecies were fulfilled by Jesus Christ:

Acts 3 verses 22 to 24

The apostle Peter also says that Jesus is the fulfillment of the promise to Abraham that all nations will be blessed through one of his descendants:

Acts 3 verses 25 and 26

Paul tells his hearers that several prophecies were fulfilled when Jesus was put to death:

Acts 13 verses 27 to 29
