Summary Points

- v 1 and 2 Jesus is our example (see theme)
- **v 3 to 13** Life can be hard, but God develops us through our experiences
- v 14 to 17 We should try to live good, peaceable lives acceptable to God, unlike Esau who failed to value his birthright and as a consequence lost his blessing
- v 18 to 29 The people and Moses were fearful when God spoke to them on the mountain. Jesus is the mediator of the new covenant. We should heed God's words so that we can serve him acceptably
