Summary Points

- v 1 to 8 Problems in life (see theme) can shape our characters. God will help us to become wise if we ask in faith
- v 9 to 15 We will all fade away like grass, but will receive a crown of life if we are approved. Bad thoughts and actions lead to sin (see theme) and death. They come from within ourselves and we cannot blame God
- v 16 to 27 The word of God will help us to live good lives. It will save us if we try to do what it says

A selection of verses showing how this theme runs consistently through the Bible.

God tells Moses that he is testing the early Israelites when they encounter problems. He wants to see if they will continue to obey him:

Deuteronomy 8 verses 2 - 3

God is testing king Hezekiah when princes from Babylon come to him:

2 Chronicles 32 verse 31

James tells us to appreciate that trials can be good for us:

James 1 verses 2 - 4

The apostle Peter encourages us to continue faithful despite difficult times to come:

1 Peter 1 verses 6 - 7

He also warns us to expect trials in our lives:

1 Peter 4 verse 12

Sin - a serious matter

The word sin means to miss the mark. We sin when we don't achieve what God would like us to do. A selection of verses showing the serious results of sin.

The apostle James tells us that we sin as a result of our own natural desires. He also points out the consequences:

James 1 verses 14 -and 15

The apostle Paul tells his fellow Jews that they are no better than non-Jews because we are all sinners:

Romans 3 verses 9 and 10

He also spells out the serious consequences of sin:

Romans 5 verse 12

The book of Genesis tells us what God says when he passes sentence on the man through whom sin enters the world. The results are with us still:

Genesis 3 verses 17 to 19

The apostle John tells us that we are deceiving ourselves if we deny that we are sinners:

1 John 1 verse 8
