Questions

- 1. What does David ask the LORD to do for him because he is faint and troubled?
- 2. What does David say about death?
- 3. How do we know that David is confident that God will answer this prayer?

Summary Points

- v 1 to 7 David is in the depths of despair. He pleads that he can be saved from death and from his adversaries
- v 8 to 10 David is confident that God hears his prayers (see theme) and his enemies will be turned away

God listens to prayer

A selection of verses about God listening to prayer.

Several Psalms tell us that God will hear our prayers:

Psalm 65 verse 2, 86 verse 7

Through the prophets Isaiah and Jeremiah, God says he hears prayer:

Isaiah 65 verse 24

Jeremiah 29 verses 12 and 13

Jesus tells us that requests are only responded to if his words remain in us:

John 15 verse 7

God hears the prayer of Cornelius:

Acts 10 verse 31

The apostle John tells us that God responds to requests that are according to his will:

1 John 5 verse 14
