Week 4 Day 1 Mark 16 Understand your Bible reading plan





Introduction

Jesus is raised from the dead and is seen by his followers. He then goes from them, into heaven.

Questions

- 1. When did the women come to the tomb?
- 2. Who was the first disciple to meet the risen Jesus?
- 3. How many times, according to Mark, did Jesus appear and talk to the disciples after he was raised?



A tomb similar to one where Jesus would have been buried (v 2).



Summary Points

- v 1 to 8 Some of Jesus' disciples go to the tomb very early on the first day of the week, and find the tomb empty. A young man in white (an angel) tells them that Jesus has risen from the dead (see theme)
- v 9 to 13 Jesus appears on several occasions to a number of his disciples
- v 14 to 18 Jesus appears to the eleven disciples and reprimands them because they didn't believe he had risen. Jesus tells the disciples to preach that those who believe and are baptised will be saved
- v 19 and 20 Jesus ascends into heaven and the disciples start to preach the good news

Jesus rose from the dead

Jesus himself tells his disciples that he will rise from the dead:

Matthew 16 verse 21, 17 verse 9

Luke 18 verses 31 to 33

The Gospel writers confirm that Jesus has risen from the dead:

Matthew 28 verses 5 and 6

Mark 16 verses 5 and 6

The resurrection of Jesus is part of the message the apostle Peter gives:

Acts 10 verses 39 and 40

The apostle Paul gives the same message:

Acts 13 verses 29 to 31
