- v 1 to 3 David says that with the LORD as his shepherd he is provided for and guided in right paths
- v 4 to 6 The LORD will keep him from danger and evil throughout his life and show him kindness and love (see theme)

The prophet Hanani tells king Asa that God sees all that happens, so Asa is foolish not to trust him:

2 Chronicles 16 verse 9

Job is aware that God sees all that happens:

Job 34 verse 21

The psalmist, the writer of the book of Proverbs and the prophet Jeremiah all tell us that God's eyes are everywhere:

Psalm 34 verse 15

Proverbs 15 verse 3

Jeremiah 16 verse 17

The apostle Peter tells us that God hears our prayers as well as seeing all we do:

1 Peter 3 verse 12
