# **Summary Points**

- v 1 and 2 We are blessed if our sins are forgiven
- v 3 to 7 David eventually confessed his sin and was forgiven. Likewise we can be forgiven and preserved from trouble if we confess our sins (see theme)
- v 8 to 11 There is a right way to go. We should trust in the LORD and be glad and rejoice


