Summary Points

- v 1 to 4 God is great, the creator of the heavens
- v 5 to 9 God created the earth and the seas
- v 10 to 18 God provides water, food and care for man, the animals and the birds
- v 19 to 23 The seasons are appointed by God
- v 24 to 32 All land and sea creatures depend on the God who creates them and lets them die
- v 33 to 35 The psalmist wants to praise God all his life, but realises that God will destroy the wicked (see theme)

The wicked will be judged

A selection of verses showing that the wicked will be judged.

The Psalms and the book of Ecclesiastes tell us that God will judge the wicked:

Psalm 145 verse 20

Ecclesiastes 3 verse 17

The prophet Isaiah says that a descendant of Jesse (v 1) will judge the wicked:

Isaiah 11 verse 4

The apostle Paul tells the believers in Rome that God is against all ungodliness:

Romans 1 verse 18

He also tells them that God's judgement will fall on those who refuse to repent:

Romans 2 verses 4 and 5
