Theme

The power and permanence of God

A selection of verses showing that God is all-powerful and never changes.

King David tells the Israelites of God's greatness:

1 Chronicles 29 verses 10 and 11

The psalmist makes it clear that God has great power:

Psalm 147 verses 4 to 8

The prophet Jeremiah echoes the same thoughts:

Jeremiah 51 verses 15 and 16

God uses his power to bring about our salvation:

2 Peter 1 verses 3 and 4

The apostle James reminds us that God doesn't change:

James 1 verse 17
