## Summary Points

## Theme

### **The power and permanence of God**

*A selection of verses showing that God is all-powerful and never changes.*

King David tells the Israelites of God's greatness:

*1 Chronicles 29 verses 10 and 11*

The psalmist makes it clear that God has great power:

*Psalm 147 verses 4 to 8*

The prophet Jeremiah echoes the same thoughts:

*Jeremiah 51 verses 15 and 16*

God uses his power to bring about our salvation:

*2 Peter 1 verses 3 and 4*

The apostle James reminds us that God doesn't change:

*James 1 verse 17*
