Moses reminds the early Israelites that God has tested them for their good:

Deuteronomy 8 verse 3

The book of Lamentations tells us that punishment for sins can encourage us to turn to the LORD:

Lamentations 3 verses 39 to 41

Paul tells the Roman believers that all things, good and bad, work towards a good end for them:

Romans 8 verse 28, 38 and 39
