- v 4 to 7 People and seasons come and go
- v 8 to 11 Natural life is unsatisfying (see theme) and former things are forgotten
- v 12 to 18 The Preacher realises that human wisdom brings no lasting advantage. At the end of the book (chapter 12 v 13) he gives his conclusions. "Fear God and keep his commandments; for this is the whole duty of man."
