Summary Points

- v 1 and 2 The apostle Peter writes to believers scattered throughout Asia Minor (part of modern Turkey)
- v 3 to 9 We can hope for eternal life (see theme) if we endure the trials which develop our faith
- v 10 to 12 Hebrew prophets foretold the salvation which would come through the saving work of Christ
- v 13 to 22 Understanding Christ's sacrifice we should live new lives, fearing and obeying God
- v 23 to 25 We all die, but the word of God that we have heard, cannot perish and leads to salvation

Theme

God's plan gives us the hope of eternal life

A selection of verses showing this theme. The apostle Paul confirms that the outcome of God's plan of salvation is eternal life: Titus 1 verses 1 and 2 Eternal life is referred to in the Psalms: Psalm 133 verse 3 Daniel also speaks of this prospect for those who are written in God's book: Daniel 12 verses 1 and 2 We can have eternal life if we believe in Jesus Christ: John 3 verses 14 to 16 Paul also confirms that God will give eternal life to those who believe in Jesus Christ: Romans 6 verse 23
