Summary Points

- v 1 to 10 We should put away all bad thoughts and absorb the Word. Jesus is the supreme stone but is rejected by unbelievers. We should aim to be holy, fit to be stones in God's spiritual temple with Jesus
- v 11 to 17 We should obey the authorities and fear God
- v 18 to 25 We should serve employers well whether they are good or bad. Christ suffered for us and we should follow his example (see theme)
