Summary Points

- v 1 to 3 Peter warns that false teachers (see theme) will come in, attempting to deceive the believers
- **v 4 to 19** God has punished the wicked in the past but saved a few godly people. Punishment will also happen to those believers who turn their backs on their Lord and Saviour
- v 20 to 22 Converts who turn their back on the gospel have no hope

The apostle Paul tells the believers at Ephesus and Colossae to resist deceptive ideas:

Ephesians 5 verse 6 Colossians 2 verse 4 and 8

The apostle Paul gives several warnings that believers will encounter wrong ideas:

1 Timothy 4 verses 1 and 2

2 Timothy 4 verses 3 and 4


The apostle John tells the believers to test the spirits (ideas) they come across:
