Summary Points

- **v 1 to 5** God is thanked for destroying strong dreaded nations and for protecting the poor and needy
- **v 6 to 8** There will come a time of plenty and God will put an end to suffering and death (see theme)
- **v 9 to 12** God's people will rejoice in their salvation, but Moab will be brought down

The apostle Paul confirms that the outcome of God's plan of salvation is eternal life:

Titus 1 verses 1 and 2

Eternal life is referred to in the Psalms:

Psalms 133 verse 3

Daniel also speaks of this prospect for those who are written in God's book:

Daniel 12 verses 1 and 2

We can have eternal life if we believe in Jesus Christ:

John 3 verses 14 to 16

Paul also confirms that God will give eternal life to those who believe in Jesus Christ:

Romans 6 verse 23
