Summary Points

- **v 1 to 5** A picture of a world ruled by a just king (see theme)
- **v 6 to 12** Meanwhile foolish men practise wickedness and self-satisfied women will see famine come
- **v 13 to 15** The land and cities will be forsaken until God pours out his Spirit and the desolation is reversed
- **v 16 to 20** God's people will enjoy a time of justice and peace

God's special person will improve our world

A selection of verses showing how God's special person will improve our world.

The prophet Isaiah foretells how he will have a strong, endless, just government:

Isaiah 9 verses 6 and 7

He also says that, having the Lord's influence, his rule will be wise, and considerate of the poor:

Isaiah 11 verses 2 to 4

The prophet Micah gives more details of his firm but kind rule:

Micah 4 verses 2 to 4

The book of Revelation tells us that God plans to make our world a much better place:

Revelation 21 verses 3 and 4
