1. How does Jeremiah describe the sin of Judah?
2. What does the LORD say about where we should put our trust?
3. What does the LORD do after searching minds and trying hearts?



## Summary Points

- **v 1 to 4** The people of Judah have worshipped idols and so will be taken from their land
- **v 5 to 10** We are encouraged to trust in God, not man and so be blessed. The LORD knows our hearts and minds and that we are all basically wicked (see theme)
- **v 11 to 18** Jeremiah recognises the LORD as his hope and salvation, and the one who can protect him
- **v 19 to 27** The LORD tells Jeremiah to command the people of Jerusalem to keep the Sabbath. If they do this the city will continue, but if not it will be destroyed
