Introduction

Questions

- 1. What does the Lord GOD say about someone who has walked in his statutes and kept his ordinances?
- 2. What does the Lord GOD say about someone who has wronged the poor and needy and has taken by robbery?
- 3. How does the Lord GOD say he will judge the house of Israel?



Summary Points

- v 1 to 4 The people of Israel have a proverb that says the children will suffer for the sins of their fathers (see theme)
- v 5 to 18 GOD gives examples of good and bad behaviour leading to life and death
- v 19 to 24 Individuals are judged on their own behaviour and GOD wants the wicked to turn from his evil ways
- v 25 to 29 GOD argues that his ways are fair
- v 30 to 32 GOD will judge Israel and wants them to change their ways and live

2 Samuel 12 verse 9 and 13
